Advertisement for Request for Contractor Prequalification

Notice is hereby given that the Del City Municipal Services Authority, hereinafter called the "Owner", is Requesting Qualifications for the Del City Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements. Prequalification Document Packets will be received by the City Clerk at the Del City City Hall, 3701 SE 15th Street, Del City, Oklahoma 73115 until **2:00 p.m.** on **December 8, 2016**, at which time the Owner will open submissions in a public meeting. All Prequalification Packets received at said time will be opened; however, contractor attendance is not required.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Prequalification Packets deemed non-responsive, non-responsible or does not meet minimum qualification as stated in the Prequalification Documents.

A **Mandatory** Prequalification Conference will be held on **December 1, 2016 at 1:30 pm** in the City Council Chambers, City of Del City, 3701 SE 15th Street, Del City, Oklahoma 73115. Prequalification Conference attendance is mandatory for all prospective bidders on this project and shall be limited to three personnel per organization.

In general, the completed Work is described as follows:

Improvements to the existing wastewater treatment plant (WWTP), including new headworks, sequencing batch reactor process upgrades, new tertiary filters, new UV disinfection system, aerobic digestion process upgrades, rehabilitation of various tanks and existing facilities, and other improvements.

Pre-Qualified bidders who are invited to Bid on this project will be required to comply with the following during the Bid Document Submittal process:

- Original bid, filed according to Bid Documents, accompanied by a certified or Cashier's Check on a solvent bank located in Oklahoma or a Bidder's Bond, in the amount of five (5) percent of the amount bid, as a guarantee of his ability to perform the contract bid upon, and that he will enter into a written contract with the Owner to perform said work and/or furnish said materials in accordance with said plans and specifications and furnish the required bonds within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award is executed.
- The Owner as will retain the deposit, and for, liquidated damages in case the successful bidder fails to enter in said contract and furnish the required bonds provided for in the specifications within the time required. Deposit of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned upon the execution of the Contract and required bonds.
- Each bidder shall accompany his bid with a sworn statement in writing that the Bidder has not directly or indirectly entered into an agreement, expressed or implied, with any other bidder concerning the price or amount of such bid or any bids, the limiting of the bids or bidders, the paying to anyone any money for promotion expenses, the parceling or farming out to any bidder or bidders or other persons of any part of the contract or any part of the subject matter of the bid or of the profits thereof.
- Performance, Maintenance and Statutory Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price with a Corporate Surety licensed in Oklahoma and approved by the Owner and Engineer, will be required for the faithful performance of the contract, and the bidder shall state in the proposal the name and address of the Surety or Sureties who will sign this bond in case the contract is awarded to him. The Maintenance Bond required will guarantee the repair of all damage due to improper materials or workmanship for a period of one (1) year after the acceptance of the work by the Owner.
- The City of Del City is exempt from the payment of any sales or use taxes. Pursuant to Title 68 O.S., Section 1356 (10) and as allowed by Oklahoma Tax Commission Rules Part 27 Trust Authority 710:65-13-140, direct vendors to the City of Del City are also exempt from those taxes. A

bidder and his subcontractors may exclude from their bid sales taxes on appropriate equipment, materials, and supplies that he will not have to pay while acting on behalf of the City of Del City.

This project is to be financed by a loan from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and shall be referred to as SRF Project No. ORF-16-0003-CW. The following conditions apply:

- A. Each bidder must fully comply with the requirements, terms and conditions of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB), Small, Minority, Women's Businesses Requirements including affirmative steps to contract with small, minority and women's businesses during the performance of this contract. The bidder commits itself to the affirmative steps to contract with small, minority and women's businesses contained herein and all other requirements, terms and conditions of these bid conditions by submitting a properly signed bid. Requirements are contained in Oklahoma Water Resources Board Guidance and Procedures, ORF-267" (Revised 03/15).
- B. Equal Opportunity in Employment: All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age or handicap. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.
- C. Davis Bacon Act wage rules shall apply. All laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors on projects funded directly by or assisted in whole or in part by and through the Federal Government shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on projects of a character similar in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with subchapter IV of Chapter 31 of Title 40, United States Code. The Department of Labor provides all pertinent information related to compliance with labor standards, including prevailing wage rates and instructions for reporting. - D. American Iron and Steel provisions (Buy American Requirements) also apply to projects funded directly by or assisted in whole or in part by and through the Federal Government pursuant to P.L. 113-76, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014, Sec. 436 requires that "None of the funds made available by a State water pollution control revolving fund as authorized by title VI of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.) or made available by a drinking water treatment revolving loan fund as authorized by section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. 300j-12) shall be used for a project for the construction, alteration, maintenance, or repair of a public water system or treatment works unless all of the iron and steel products used in the project are produced in the United States." - E. System for Award Management (SAM) registration is required for all SRF programs (CWSRF and DWSRF) applicants and Awardees (Entities, Prime Contractors, Subcontractors, Vendors) in order to be awarded contracts by the SRF Programs. SAM replaces Central Contractor Registration/Federal Agency Registration, Online Representations and Certifications Application, and Excluded Parties List System. Applicants and awardees are required to complete a one-time free registration to provide basic information relevant to procurement and financial transactions. Registrants must retain an active status to be eligible for SRF projects. New Applicants and Awardees can go to SAM.gov to complete the registration process.
